ORDINANCE NO. 96-17-CM

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING FEES FOR DYE TESTING AND WELL WATER TESTING IN TIPPECANOE COUNTY

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 16-20-1-27 authorized the Tippecanoe County Health Department with the approval of the Tippecanoe County Commissioners to establish and collect fees for services provided by the health department ; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Tippecanoe County desire to set fees to be collected by the health department for the provision of dye testing and well water testing services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of the County of Tippecanoe as follows:

1. **TITLE.** This Ordinance and all ordinances supplemental or amendatory hereto shall be known as the Dye Test and Well Water Test Fee Ordinance of Tippecanoe County, Indiana, and may be cited as such and will be referred to herein as "this Ordinance".

2. **PURPOSE.** The purpose of this Ordinance is to establish fees for dye testing of private sewage disposal systems (hereafter referred to as "dye testing") and well water testing.

3. **FEES.** Pursuant to I.C. 16-20-1-27 the Tippecanoe County Health Department shall impose and collect a fee for dye testing and well water testing services offered by Tippecanoe County. The fees established for such testing shall be as follows:

Dye Test	\$ 50.00
Dye Test and Well Water test additional fee where test is required to include lead screening (currently required by FHA)	125.00 40.00
additional (3rd) water sample taken if needed, provided after well properly disinfected	40.00
