

**ORDINANCE NO. 95-18-CM**

**WHEREAS**, it has been determined by the Board of Commissioners of Tippecanoe County, upon the basis of an Engineering and Traffic Investigation, that the prima facie speed permitted by the laws of the State of Indiana is greater than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist on County Road 50 North from Frontage Road to County Road 550 East.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Commissioners of Tippecanoe County, Indiana, that reasonable and safe prima facie speed limits on **County Road 50 North**, shall be as follows, to-wit:

From Frontage Road to Shady Creek Drive the maximum speed limit shall be 30 mph.

From Shady Creek Drive to County Road 550 East the maximum speed limit shall be 35 mph.

**AND BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED** that said reasonable and safe prima facie speed limits shall become effective April 17, 1995.


