

**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-22-CM**  
**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING**  
**LAW ENFORCEMENT FIREARMS RANGE SUPPORT FUND**

WHEREAS, members of law enforcement agencies in Tippecanoe County require a firearms range in order to enable them to safely and effectively use firearms in the course of their work; and

WHEREAS, the existing firearms range may become unavailable for the use of members of law enforcement agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Tippecanoe County, Indiana has determined that a need now exists for the establishment of a Fund for the deposit and disbursement of monies to be used for developing and maintaining a law enforcement firearms range;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby created in the office of Auditor of Tippecanoe County a separate fund to be known as the Law Enforcement Firearms Range Support Fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that monies may be expended from such fund only for the purpose of developing and maintaining a firearms range for training of members of law enforcement agencies in Tippecanoe County.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that interest on such fund shall be deposited to the Tippecanoe County General Fund. .
