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MAINTENANCE REPORT
N.W. BOX #12 REGULATED DRAIN
TIPPECANOE COUNTY DRAINAGE BOARD

The N.W. Box Regulated Drain was originally established by the Tippecanoe County Circuit Court in 1915 as Case No. 2941. The drain and its watershed are located in sections 17, 19, 20, 29, 30, 31 and 32 of Township 24 North and Range 5 West and section 36 of Township 24 North and Range 6 West in the political township of Shelby and Sections 16, 21, 28 and 33 of Township 24 North and Range 5 West in the political township of Wabash all located inside Tippecanoe County, Indiana.

The N.W. Box drain maintenance fund was established by the Tippecanoe County Drainage Board on January 9, 1974 at a rate of \$0.75 per acre.


There are approximately 26,180 lineal feet of open ditch to be maintained by this maintenance fund. There is no tile associated with or to be maintained by this maintenance fund. The watershed contains 3684.52 acres.

It is the recommendation of the Tippecanoe County Surveyor that a sum of \$118,492.00 is needed to maintain and improve the existing open ditch system.

An assessment of \$3.75 per acre and a \$20.00 minimum collected over an 8 year period is recommended. This will generate \$113,449.27 over an 8 year period.

It is the professional opinion of the Tippecanoe County Surveyor this rate increase will ensure that monies will be generated for ongoing and future maintenance of this system.
