

COMBINATION OF DRAINS AND ANNUAL MAINTENANCE

This matter came to be heard upon the maintenance report and schedule of assessments prepared by the Tippecanoe County Drainage Board and filed on April 1, 1986. Certificate of mailing of notice of time and place of hearing, to all affected landowners filed. Notice of publication of the time and place of hearing in the Journal and Courier and Crawfordsville were filed. April 25, 1986 & April 27, 1986
Journal Review
Remonstrances were (were not) filed.

Evidence was presented by the Tippecanoe County Surveyor and many of those landowners affected were present. A list of those present is filed herewith.

After consideration of all the evidence, the Board does now FIND THAT:

- 1) The maintenance report of the Tippecanoe County Surveyor and schedule of assessments were filed in the office of the Surveyor on _____.
- 2) Notice of filing of the maintenance report and the schedule of assessments and their availability for inspection and the time and place of this hearing was mailed to all those landowners affected more than thirty (30) and less than forty (40) days before the date of this hearing.
- 3) Notice of the time and place of this hearing was given by publication in the Journal & Courier & Crawfordsville Journal Review newspapers of general circulation in Lafayette & _____, Indiana more than ten (10) days prior to this hearing.
Crawfordsville
- 4) The legal drain consists of 2600' feet of open ditch, 100 feet of tile in the main ditch and 6700 feet of ~~open~~ tile ditch in the branches.
- 5) The largest diameter tile is 18" inches.
- 6) The present condition of the ditch is Needs immediate work.
- 7) The ditch needs the following maintenance at present: Remove dead trees and limbs from open channel, remove silt and regrade ditch below headwall to open tile outlet.
- 8) There is now 0.00 owed to the General Drain fund for past maintenance on this ditch.
- 9) The ditch drains 1,242.90 acres.
- 10) Estimated annual cost of maintenance is \$1,247.33.
- 11) Estimated annual benefits the land drained exceeds 12500.00.
- 12) A fund for annual maintenance should (~~should not~~) be established.
- 13) In order to provide the necessary maintenance fund, the annual assessment per acre benefitted should be \$ 1.00.
- 14) The assessment list filed herewith should be amended as follows: _____




