**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING SPEED LIMITS
ON COUNTY ROAD 650 WEST
FROM JACKSON HIGHWAY TO US 52,
ON JACKSON HIGHWAY FROM STATE ROAD 26
TO COUNTY ROAD 650 WEST,
ON COUNTY ROAD 600 NORTH FROM BATTLEGROUND CITY LIMITS
TO COUNTY ROAD 50 WEST,
ON COUNTY ROAD 300 NORTH FROM STATE ROAD 25
TO COUNTY ROAD 900 EAST,
ON STOCKWELL ROAD FROM US 52 TO A POINT 600 FEET NORTH OF COUNTY
ROAD 900 SOUTH (ATTICA STREET),
ON COUNTY ROAD 700 EAST FROM A POINT 600 FEET NORTH OF COUNTY ROAD
900 SOUTH (ATTICA STREET) TO
SOUTH COUNTY LINE ROAD,
ON COUNTY ROAD 510 SOUTH FROM
WEA SCHOOL ROAD TO OLD US 231,
ON COUNTY ROAD 500 SOUTH FROM OLD US 231
TO UNION TOWNSHIP LIMITS,
AND ON COUNTY ROAD 350 SOUTH FROM STATE ROAD 38
TO LAFAYETTE CORPORATION LIMITS
IN TIPPECANOE COUNTY**

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Board of Commissioners of Tippecanoe County, based on engineering and traffic investigations, that the present speed limit, established by Indiana Code, of 55 miles per hour is greater than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist on Jackson Highway from State Road 26 to County Road 650 West; on County Road 600 North from Battleground corporation limits to County Road 50 West; on County Road 300 North from State Road 25 to County Road 900 East; on Stockwell Road from US 52 to a point 600 feet North of County Road 900 South (Attica Street); on County Road 700 East from a point 2,100 feet North of County Road 1000 South to South County Line Road; on County Road 510 South from Wea School Road to Old US 231; on County Road 500 South from Old US 231 to Union Township corporation limits; and on County Road 350 South from State Road 38 to Lafayette corporation limits; and that the present speed limit, established by Indiana Code, of 30 miles per hour is greater than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist on County Road 700 East from a point 600 feet North of County Road 900 South (Attica Street) to a point 2,100 feet North of County Road 1000 South; and on County Road 650 West from Jackson Highway to US 52.

WHEREAS, IN ADDITION, it has also been determined by the Board of Commissioners of Tippecanoe County, upon the basis of engineering and traffic investigations, that the prima facie speed permitted by the laws of the State of Indiana is greater than is reasonable or safe under the conditions found to exist on County Road 650 West from Jackson Highway to US 52; on Jackson Highway from State Road 26 to County Road 650 West; on County Road 600 North from Battleground corporation limits to County Road 50 West; on County Road 300 North from State Road 25 to County Road 900 East; on Stockwell Road from US 52 to a point 600 feet North of County Road 900 South (Attica Street) to South County Line Road; on County Road 510 South from Wea School Road to Old US 231; on County Road 500 South from Old US 231 to Union Township corporation limits; and on County Road 350 South from State Road 38 to Lafayette corporation limits.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF TIPPECANOE COUNTY, STATE OF INDIANA, THAT the reasonable and safe prima facie speed permitted on County Road 650 West from Jackson Highway to US 52; on Jackson Highway from State Road 26 to County Road 650 West; on County Road 600 North from Battleground corporation limits to County Road 50 West; on County Road 300 North from State Road 25 to County Road 900 East; on Stockwell Road from US 52 to a point 600 feet North of County Road 900 South (Attica Street); on County Road 700 East from a point 600 feet North of County Road 900 South (Attica Street) to South County Line Road; on County Road 510 South from Wea School Road to Old US 231; on County Road 500 South from Old US 231 to Union Township corporation limits; and on County Road 350 South from State Road 38 to Lafayette corporation limits shall be as follows, to-wit:

On County Road 650 West from US 52 to Jackson Highway, the maximum speed limit shall be 25 miles per hour.

On Jackson Highway from State Road 26 to County Road 475 West, the maximum speed limit shall be 45 miles per hour.

On Jackson Highway from County Road 475 West to County Road 350 North (East leg), the maximum speed limit shall be 55 miles per hour.

On Jackson Highway from County Road 350 North (East leg) to County Road 650 West, the maximum speed limit shall be 35 miles per hour.

On County Road 600 North from Battleground corporation limits to a point 3,900 feet West of State Road 43, the maximum speed limit shall be 40 miles per hour.

On County Road 600 North from a point 3,900 feet West of State Road 43 to County Road 50 West, the maximum speed limit shall be 50 miles per hour.

On County Road 300 North from State Road 25 to County Road 350 East, the maximum speed limit shall be 25 miles per hour.

On County Road 300 North from County Road 350 East to a point 1,800 feet West of County Road 500 East, the maximum speed limit shall be 50 miles per hour.

On County Road 300 North from a point 1,800 feet West of County Road 500 East to a point 1,700 feet East of County Road 500 East, the maximum speed limit shall be 35 miles per hour.

On County Road 300 North from a point 1,700 feet East of County Road 500 East to County Road 900 East, the maximum speed limit shall be 55 miles per hour.

On Stockwell Road from US 52 to a point 600 feet North of County Road 900 South (Attica Street), the maximum speed limit shall be 50 miles per hour.

On County Road 700 East from a point 600 feet North of County Road 900 South (Attica Street) to a point 2,100 feet North of County Road 1000 South, the maximum speed limit shall be 25 miles per hour.

On County Road 700 East from a point 2,100 feet North of County Road 1000 South to South County Line Road, the maximum speed limit shall be 55 mile per hour.

On County Road 510 South from Wea School Road to Old US 231, the maximum speed limit shall be 45 miles per hour.

On County Road 500 South from Old US 231 to US 231, the maximum speed limit shall be 35 miles per hour.

On County Road 500 South from US 231 to Union Township corporation limits, the maximum speed limit shall be 50 miles per hour.

On County Road 350 South from State Road 38 to Lafayette corporation limits, the maximum speed limit shall be 50 miles per hour.

IT IS FURTHER ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF TIPPECANOE COUNTY, STATE OF INDIANA, THAT said reasonable and safe maximum speed limits shall become effective the 2nd day of August, 2004.


PENALTY FOR VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE


