ORDINANCE NO. 2009-25-CL AMENDING TIPPECANOE COUNTY CODE

ADDING NEW SECTION 34.39

COMMUNITY CORRECTIONS DEPARTMENT JUVENILE ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM FEE SCHEDULE

WHEREAS, Indiana Code 36-1-3-1 to 9, inclusive, grants certain home rule powers to Counties; and

WHEREAS, the Tippecanoe County Community Corrections Department's Juvenile Alternatives Program from time to time provides certain unique alternative services to juveniles referred by the Juvenile Court and local schools through the use of intervention, mediation, supervision, and education services. These services are provided to delinquent and non-delinquent minors in effort to improve behavior and deter progression through the juvenile justice system; and

WHEREAS, the Community Corrections Department desires to establish a uniform schedule of fees and charges for participation in such programs; and the Tippecanoe County Council desires to authorize the collection of such fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Tippecanoe County Council, that the Tippecanoe County Code be amended to add a new Section 34.39 reading as follows:

§ 34.39 JUVENILE ALTERNATIVES PROGRAM FEE SCHEDULE.
