Whereas, Ron Buchanan, petitioner, have filed a petition pursuant to IC-36-7-3-12 to vacate a public way (Sycamore Street) in the town of Granville, Wayne Township, Tippecanoe County, Indiana; and

Whereas, proper notice was given to al abutting land owners; and

Whereas, a public hearing was held on Monday, October 17, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. on the petition; and

Whereas, the Commissioners have determined that the petition is in order and should be granted;

Whereas, the public way has existed for many years and is not improved.



This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and signing.




