

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-13-CM
AMENDING TIPPECANOE COUNTY CODE
REPEALING SECTION 151.06
ADDING NEW SECTION 151.06
APPLICATION FOR PERMITS

WHEREAS, The Board of Commissioners has determined that it will be of public utility and benefit to require documents filed with the Tippecanoe County Building Commission which exceed 11" by 17" to be submitted in digital format to facilitate records retention and storage;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Board of Commissioners of Tippecanoe County, Indiana, that the Tippecanoe County Code be amended to repeal Section 151.06 Application for Permits and add a new Section 151.06 Application for Permits reading as follows:

§151.06 APPLICATION FOR PERMITS.

No permits shall be issued for the foregoing purposes, unless the application for such permit is accompanied by plans and specifications showing the work to be done, and listing the area of each level of the building and of the garage in square feet. All plans for building construction under the authority of the Fire Prevention and Building Safety Commission of the State of Indiana must also be filed with the Office of the State Building Commissioner if a state construction design release is required. No local permits shall be issued hereunder until a copy of a construction design release from the State Building Commission is received by the County Building Commissioner if such construction design release is required.

§151.061 DIGITAL DATA SUBMISSION.

(A) The uniform digital data submission standards for established pursuant to Tippecanoe County Code Section 31.124 are hereby adopted as the standards for the submission of data to the office of the Tippecanoe County Building Commission.

(B) All documents submitted to the Tippecanoe County Building Commission which exceed 11" by 17" in overall size, shall also be submitted digitally in a format which complies with the digital submission requirements set forth in Section 31.124.

(C) The Tippecanoe County Building Commission shall have 30 days from the date of such submission to review and approve such digital data submission, otherwise the submission shall be deemed acceptable.

(D) If the Tippecanoe County Building Commission determines that the digital data submission fails to meet the standards, the Tippecanoe County Building Commission shall notify the party submitting such digital data of such determination in writing and the submitting party shall have 30 days from the date of such notification to correct and resubmit such data.


This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect on the 18th day of April, 2012.
