

ORDINANCE NO. 2012- 18 -CL

**ORDINANCE APPROVING TIPPECANOE COUNTY
SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT
PROPERTY TAX LEVY**

WHEREAS, the Tippecanoe County Solid Waste Management District was established on February 29, 2012 pursuant to Ordinance 2012-12-CM in accordance with the provisions of Indiana Code 13-21-3 for the purpose of reducing the amount of solid and hazardous waste created and disposed within the district; and

WHEREAS, Tippecanoe County Solid Waste Management District is authorized by IC 13-21-3-12(13) to levy a tax within the district to pay costs of operation in connection with Solid Waste Management, subject to regular budget and tax levy procedures and the requirements of IC 13-21-3-16; and

WHEREAS, the Tippecanoe County Solid Waste Management District duly adopted a Resolution on March 16, 2012 requesting the fiscal body of Tippecanoe County to approve the imposition of a property tax within the district to pay the costs of operation of the district in fiscal year 2013 and thereafter at a proposed tax rate of **\$0.0032** cents per hundred; and








WHEREAS, the proposed tax levy must be approved by the Tippecanoe County Council on or before May 1, 2012; (1) a “yes” vote indicates approval of the levy and the proposed use of property tax revenue within the district; and (2) a “no” vote indicates disapproval of the levy and the proposed use of property tax revenue within the district; and

WHEREAS, the Tippecanoe County Council desires to approve the imposition of a property tax within the district to pay the costs of operation of the district in connection with solid waste management.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County Council of the County of

Tippecanoe does hereby approve and recommend the imposition of an ad valorem property tax levy in the approximate amounts of **\$201,015** for Tippecanoe County, to support funding of the fiscal year 2013 budget of the Tippecanoe County Solid Waste Management District and recommends same to the Indiana Department of Local Government Finance for final determination of the district's property tax levy and tax rate in accordance with IC 6-1.1-18.5-7.








