

## Tenant Assistance for Evictions

On September 2, 2020, the Department of Health and Human Services, Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) issued a temporary halt in residential evictions (effective September 4, 2020). Landlords may still file eviction actions if they believe their tenants are not covered by this Order or for lease violation issues other than non-payment of rent.

If the Tenant believes they are covered by this Order, the Tenants may prepare and present to the court a Declaration of Eligibility. If the court determines the Tenant is covered under this Order, the eviction will be dismissed.
