

TIPPECANOE COUNTY COUNCIL
REGULAR MEETING
August 14, 2007

The Tippecanoe County Council met at 2:00 p. m. Tuesday, August 14, 2007 in the Tippecanoe Room in the County Office Building. Council members present were: President Jeffrey A. Kemper, Vice President Thomas P. Murtaugh, Andrew S. Gutwein, Betty J. Michael, Kevin Underwood, and Kathy Vernon. Others present were: Auditor Jennifer Weston, Attorney David W. Luhman, and Secretary Jennifer Prange. Absent was David S. Byers.

President Kemper called the meeting to order and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

- Councilmember Vernon moved to approve minutes from the July 10, 2007 regular meeting, second by Councilmember Underwood; motion carried.

AUDITOR'S REPORT – Jennifer Weston

Auditor Weston presented the financial report.

Wabash River Hydrology Grant Fund 333

Wabash River Enhancement Director Stan Lambert reported the Army Corps of Engineers will complete a second portion of the hydrologic and hydraulic analysis for the Wabash River project. This revenue will fund 50% of the total cost for the project.

Auditor Weston presented two salary statements for approval. She requested a new Account Manager position as well as a change in name and classification for the Administrative Assistant position. Auditor Weston also proposed eliminating the Secretary position.

OTHER BUSINESS

Director Jason Kniola presented information regarding Cary Home's 2008 budget. Projected expenses and revenue for the girl's facility were included. The modular home project is progressing and Director Kniola reported he is currently trying to obtain IV-E Reimbursement for the girl's facility. He also noted he is accepting bids for tuck point of the Cary Home facility.

YOUTH SERVICES UPDATE – Rebecca Humphrey

Youth Services Director Rebecca Humphrey presented a six month review of her job performance. Her review included accomplishments, development of new curriculum, and plans for the remainder of 2007.

DEPARTMENT OF CHILD SERVICES – Angela Smith Grossman

Angela Smith Grossman provided her projected budget for 2008. She reported her budget request has increased this year in an attempt to eliminate the ongoing deficit and also to remain compliant with payment of services rendered.

COMMISSIONER FYI

Commissioner Benson reported the purchase of a narcotic's dog and a handler from grant funds for use by the Sheriff's Department. Also, she added the Assessor, Auditor, Treasurer and MITS department heads are reviewing proposals for the new Tax and Assess program.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

- Councilmember Michael moved to bring the tabled item to the table, second by Underwood; motion carried.

Georgia Jones, Deputy Assessor, confirmed that the request for appropriation is for a new COMOT III position with job duties performed by an existing employee. She added with approval for this appropriation, a full time position will be open in the Assessor's office and the part time will be reduced.

Councilmember Murtaugh proposed transferring funds from part time to full time within the Reassessment Fund 281 to meet the shortfall.

- Councilmember Murtaugh moved to approve from Fund 281- \$1,000 for salary, \$77 for Social Security, and \$60 for retirement, second by Councilmember Gutwein; motion carried.






President Kemper reminded council members that budget hearings will start on Tuesday, August 21, 2007 at 8:00 a.m. in the Tippecanoe Room.






