- **You must complete only the top half of the Interrogatories to the Employer and only the top half of the Order**
 - **File one copy of the forms with the Court**
 - **Send one copy of the forms to the Employer**
 - **Send one copy of the forms to the Judgment Debtor**
- **Make sure you comply with Administrative Rule 9(G) and include both a copy on:**
 - **White paper (only include the last four numbers of the Social Security Number of the Judgment Debtor) and**
 - **Light green paper (include the full Social Security Number of the Judgment Debtor)**

(5) Is the Debtor paid by your business by cash, check or direct deposit or some other method?
(6) List all other wages, salary, commissions, tips, rebates, profits or income the Debtor draws or receives from your
business other than listed above
(7) Does the Debtor have any other garnishments or wage attachments on his/her earnings?

IMPORTANT INFORMATION CONCERNING THIS ORDER TO ANSWER INTERROGATORIES

(1) Previously in this cause, a money judgment was entered in favor of the Judgment Creditor and against the Judgment Debtor.

(2) Anytime a Judgment is not paid in full within thirty (30) days of the date the Judgment was entered and the parties have not come to an agreement regarding a schedule for payments, the Judgment Creditor may ask the Court to order the Judgment Debtor to appear in court and be questioned under oath about income, assets and other resources that could be used to pay this Judgment. This procedure is called a Proceeding Supplemental.

The Court may also Order the Debtor's employer or financial institution or any other person or entity who may be holding monies payable to or other assets on behalf of the Debtor to answer questions (Interrogatories) about any monies or assets. The employer or financial institution is required to fully comply with the Order to provide this information.

(3) Until this Judgment is paid in full, the Judgment Creditor may regularly file Proceedings Supplemental to have the Debtor appear in court and to be questioned about income, assets and other resources that could be used to pay this Judgment. The Judgment Creditor may also ask the Court to issue a Final Order in Garnishment so that payments will automatically be deducted from wages or income earned or on deposit in a financial institution.
