The Indiana Child Support Rules and Guidelines state that a child support order may be modified if a party can demonstrate a substantial and continuing change in circumstances that makes the current child support amount ordered unreasonable or that the amount of support ordered at least twelve (12) months earlier differs from the current child support order by more than twenty percent (20%). A change in circumstances may include a change in the income of the parents, the application of a parenting plan, the failure to comply with a parenting plan, or a change in the expense of child rearing specifically considered in the guidelines.
