

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-16-CM**  
**RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING OPIOIDS SETTLEMENT FUND**

WHEREAS, Tippecanoe County has or will receive funds pursuant to opioid litigation or settlements as defined in IC 4-6-15; and

WHEREAS, Tippecanoe County wishes to create a non-reverting fund to receive said funds; and

WHEREAS, said funds should be used for purposes permitted under IC 4-6-15;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby created in the office of Auditor of Tippecanoe County a separate, non-reverting fund to be known as the Opioids Settlement Fund;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED monies may be deposited into such fund from opioids litigation or settlements as defined in IC 4-6-15, money appropriated for deposit in the fund, transfers from other County funds, donations, gifts, and from such other sources as may be determined by the County Council from time to time;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that monies may be expended from such fund for those purposes permitted under IC 4-6-15 including for programs of treatment, prevention, and care; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that interest on such fund shall be deposited to the Tippecanoe County General Fund.
